ChatGPT and Authorship in Research: Navigating the Changing Landscape

In recent months, ChatGPT, an advanced AI writing tool developed by OpenAI, has captivated the academic community with its ability to generate remarkably accurate human-like responses. As we explore the intersection of ChatGPT and authorship in research, it is essential to reconsider traditional notions and address the concerns raised by top publishers.

The growing involvement of ChatGPT in the realm of engineering and technology has sparked a vital question: Should a bot be cited as an author in research? Unlike authors of newspaper articles or books who are commissioned and remunerated, researchers rely on grants and recognition for their contributions. Authorship in research signifies their genuine and significant involvement, shaping their academic careers and reputations.

However, the use of Al writing tools like ChatGPT raises concerns about the validity and accountability of the generated text. Particularly in critical fields such as medicine, the potential impact of errors necessitates a clear understanding of who should be held responsible if ChatGPT's contribution proves problematic.

Leading publishers have taken a stance on ChatGPT's authorship. Springer Nature emphasizes that it does not meet the fundamental criteria, but they do not object to researchers utilizing AI tools with proper disclosure.

professional organizations, holds a prominent position in the country's engineering landscape. With a diverse membership of over 54,000 engineers representing various disciplines, IEB is committed to promoting excellence in engineering practices and fostering professional growth.

The Convention featured a diverse range of activities, including a National Seminar on "4th Industrial Revolution Preparedness in Society and Industry." This Seminar provided a platform for participants to explore the challenges and opportunities presented by the 4th Industrial Revolution, focusing on strategies to ensure preparedness across society and industries. The Convention offered valuable insights into the integration of digital, physical, and biological systems and their impact on various sectors.



Notably, the Convention witnessed the presence of a delegation from The Institution of Engineers (India) (IEI), led by Er C Debnath, President of IEI. The delegation included members such as Er Narendra Singh and Er Sisir Kumar Banerjee, Past Presidents of IEI, Er Masarrat Noor Khan and Er M Shyam Prasad Reddy, Council Members and Maj Gen MJS Syali, VSM (Retd), SDG, IEI. In addition, Tripura State Centre of the Institution had sent a delegation for this Convention. This attendance not only highlighted the strong ties between India and Bangladesh but also facilitated the exchange of ideas and best practices between the two nations. The delegation arrived in Bangladesh on May 12, 2023, and was warmly received by the Ex-Chairman of Chittagong Centre and the reception team from IEB. On the same day, the IEI delegation held a meeting with the President-Elect of IEB at the IEB Headquarters to discuss cooperation and rejuvenation of FEISCA (Federation of Engineering Institutions of South and Central Asia). IEB also organized a tour of their Headquarters, wherein the IEI delegation visited the office of Engr. S.M. Monjurul Hague Monju, Honorary General Secretary (Elect) of IEB, saw the medical facility that provides free treatment for all IEB members, and saw other Govt establishments located within the premises. Later in the day, Engr M A Jabbar Memorial Lecture was conducted with Chief Guest Mr. Sharif Ahmed MP, Hon'ble Minister of the Ministry of Housing & Public Works, as well as the Reception of Shaheed Engineers Family, where Lt Col Muhammad Faruk Khan (Retd) MP, Chairman of the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Foreign Affairs, served as the Chief Guest, and Engr Md Nurul Huda, President of IEB, was the Special Guest.

On May 13, 2023, the Convention was inaugurated by Her Excellency Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina of the People's Republic of Bangladesh. In her inspiring address, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina recounted her personal journey and highlighted significant milestones achieved by Bangladesh in terms of infrastructure development, industrial growth, and advancements in science and technology. She commended the invaluable contributions of engineers towards these achievements and extended a warm welcome to all the international delegates attending the Convention. The President

of IEB, the Honorary General Secretary of IEB, and the Chairman of Dhaka Centre, IEB, also delivered addresses during the inaugural session. Honorary Secretary General, Dhaka Centre, IEB, delivered the Vote of Thanks. The inaugural session witnessed the presence of a large gathering of more than 5000 people. The inaugural session was followed by the Dr Engr M A Rashid Memorial Lecture with Chief Guest Mr. S M Rezaul Karim MP, Hon'ble Minister of the Ministry of Fisheries & Livestock, and the Prof Dr Jamilur Reza Choudhury Memorial Lecture with Chief Guest Mr. Mashiur Rahman, Economic Affairs Advisor to the Prime Minister.

The National Seminar, inaugurated on May 14, 2023, was graced by Smt Matia Chowdhury, MP, Deputy Leader of the National Parliament. In the evening, a reception was organized for foreign delegates, with Engr Md Nurul Huda, President of IEB, serving as the Chief Guest. During the reception of the foreign delegates, IEI delegation exchanged mementos with IEB and delegation from Nepal Engineers' Association. While speaking on the occasion, President, IEI emphasized the imperative need for engineers to adapt to the demands of the 4th Industrial Revolution. He underscored the multidisciplinary nature of this revolution and the importance of engineers embracing disruptive technologies and collaborating across various domains. The President highlighted the significance of sustainability and emphasized that engineers play a pivotal role in addressing global challenges such as climate change, food security, and healthcare. Furthermore, he stressed the importance of strengthening collaborations between India and Bangladesh, leveraging technology for inclusive growth, and ensuring equitable distribution of the benefits arising from the 4th Industrial Revolution.

The concluding session of the National Seminar on May 15, 2023, was attended by Mr. M A Mannan MP, Hon'ble Minister of the Ministry of Planning. The Convention's closing ceremony was held on the same day, but the Hon'ble Leader of the Opposition, Bangladesh, could not come as the Chief Guest. The IEI delegation also had the opportunity to visit the Padma Multipurpose Bridge, a significant construction project across the Padma River. This steel truss bridge, carrying a four-lane highway on the upper level and a single-track railway on the lower level, is considered the most challenging construction project in the history of Bangladesh.

In addition to the convention, a meeting was held with Engr. Jahid Absar Choudhury, Director of Absar Construction Limited, and corporate members of IEI in Bangladesh to discuss the establishment of the IEI Overseas Chapter in Dhaka, Bangladesh. The discussions also focused on the possibility of considering equivalence of engineering degrees offered by prominent universities in Bangladesh, in addition to those already enlisted under the IEI database. Furthermore, validation of data of engineers from Bangladesh who are already members of IEI and the formal inauguration of the IEI Overseas Chapter in Dhaka, Bangladesh were explored.

During the discussion, Er Sisir Kumar Banerjee, Past President of IEI, highlighted that the proposal for establishing an IEI Overseas Chapter at Dhaka was initiated during his tenure as President. In December 2018, a communication was sent to Engr Md Abdus Sabur, the then President of The Institution of Engineers, Bangladesh (IEB), seeking his concurrence towards the establishment of IEI Overseas Chapter in Dhaka/Chittagong, Bangladesh. He also mentioned that the proposal received from M/s Absar Construction Ltd based in Dhaka to establish IEI Overseas Chapter in Dhaka, Bangladesh was approved by the IEI Council at its 706th Meeting held in Mumbai on 21 Sep 2019. However, due to the onset of the pandemic immediately thereafter, the proposal for establishing an IEI Overseas Chapter in Dhaka could not be taken forward. President, IEI mentioned that the ongoing initiatives to establish an Overseas Chapter in Dhaka, will help

The Institution of Engineers (India), **Uttarakhand State Centre**, Dehradun in association with the Institute of Drilling Technology, ONGC, Dehradun and Blue Water Trade Wind Private Limited organised All India Seminar on the theme **Environmental**, **Social and Governance (ESG) in Shipping and Offshore Operation** during 25-26 February 2023 at Dehradun under the aegis of Marine Engineering Division Board [MRDB] IEI. During the seminar,



domain experts delivered lectures on various pertinent issues in maritime and offshore operations, including maritime cybercrime, sea voyages, construction of artificial islands, and safety at sea. Rear Admiral O P S Rana from the Indian Navy, Ex-General Manager, Brah-Mos Aerospace, and Er K B Samal, Chief General Manager, ONGC, Dehradun, graced the inaugural function as Chief Guests. In his address, Rear Admiral Rana emphasized the new challenges faced by the shipping and sea transportation sector in the

past decade, focusing on the role of Environmental, Social, and Governance factors. Er Samal provided an introduction to drilling technology used in oil exploration and discussed environmental concerns related to Indian and overseas seashores.

During the seminar, several experts presented on various topics. Dr Prashant Aggarwal, Director of Civil Lab, Uttarakhand State Centre, IEI, demonstrated the construction of artificial islands and highlighted the challenges faced by civil engineers worldwide. Mr Avinash Vaje, Indian Registrar of Shipping, discussed Maritime Cyber Risk Management, while Er Praneet Mehta, Cofounder of JMDI Academy, addressed safety and security in sea travel and explained different indexes in maritime and shipping operations. Dr Nehal Siddiqui from Goenka University emphasized the importance of the ESG term in the shipping industry. Er Rajat Bishnoi and Er Shubham Jain from Verifavia Shipping, Chandigarh, delivered a lecture on GHG regulation in international shipping. Er R S Rahte, Ex-chief Engineer, ONGC, shared insights on handling overseas operations of drilling rigs in seabeds, specifically in Sudan and Russia. Mr Anurag Tiwari, Operations Manager at Blue Water Trade Winds, Dehradun, provided detailed information on maritime voyage optimization. Dr S K Agarwal, Ex-Director of Finance at ONGC/UJVNL, discussed financial management and explained how the maritime industry affects the world economy. A souvenir was also released during the event.

All India Seminar under the aegis of Civil Engineering Division Board

Coimbatore Local Centre, IEI organized an All India Seminar on the theme Air Quality Monitoring and Analysis: Challenges and Research Gaps in association with the Department of Civil Engineering, Kumaraguru College of Technology [KCT], Coimbatore during November 03-04, 2022 at Coimbatore under the aegis of Civil Engineering Division Board[CVDB], IEI. Dr Joseph V Thanikal, Director of KCT, graced the function as the Special Guest and addressed the audience. Dr V Selvan, Associate Professor and Head of



the Department of Civil Engineering, KCT, presented an overview of the seminar. Dr N Ramsundram, Associate Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering, KCT, provided a brief summary of the technical sessions. Dr. Sneha Gautam, Associate Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering, Karunya Institute of Technology and Sciences, Coimbatore, elaborated on the importance of air quality monitoring and its related health effects. Dr A Gandhimathi, Associate Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering, KCT, also spoke on the occasion. Earlier, Dr S Shanmugam, Chairman of the Coimbatore Local Centre, IEI, delivered the welcome address and briefed

about the activities of IEI in promoting science and technology, particularly in the context of air pollution monitoring.

In the first technical session, Dr Sneha Gautam, Associate Professor, Department of Civil Engineering, Karunya Institute of Technology and Sciences, delivered a lecture on the topic 'The Influence of COVID-19 on Air Quality in India: A Boon or Inutile.' She shared the major negative effects of COVID-19 on the social and surrounding environment, as well as the positive effects on air quality.

The second Keynote session was handled by Er Vikas Dohare, Environmental Specialist at Aeron Systems. He presented on the topic 'Monitoring of Air Pollution using Low-cost Sensors: The Technology, Opportunities, and Challenges involved in Citizen Science Projects.' He detailed the significant impacts of air pollution on the health of the population, environment, and economy, such as shortened lifespans, increased medical expenses, and reduced productivity due to lost workdays. Moreover, he emphasized that the varying accuracy of inexpensive air sensors used in various devices limits their potential, and concerns about quality still persist. Currently, low-cost air sensors are primarily used for supplemental monitoring. Additionally, technical papers were presented on topics such as 'Particulate Matter and its Health Effects - A Review,' 'A Survey on Data and Techniques for Aerosol Prediction,' and 'A Study of Environmental Impact of Air Pollution on Human Health: PM Deposition Modeling and Air Quality Modeling to Assess Ambient Air Quality Impact Due to Foundry Unit.'

Dr N Ramsundram, Associate Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering at Kumaraguru College of Technology, Coimbatore, delivered a lecture on the topic 'Myths of Modeling.' The speaker explained that modeling

(PMRDA), graced the inaugural function as the Chief Guest. Dr Amarnath C B, President, India BIM Association, Co-Chair, Digitalisation of Construction Project Management, CEDO29/P3, Bureau of Indian Standards, graced the occasion as the Guest of Honour. Dr Kavita Murugkar, Principal, Bharati Vidyapeeth of Architecture, Katraj, Pune, delivered the Keynote Address. Er Sandip Kumar Deb, Chairman, Architectural Engineering Division Board, IEI, presided over the function.

The programme started with lighting of the lamp by the dignitaries present on the dais. Dr Sanjay Bhaskar Zope, Chairman, Pune Local Centre, welcomed the guests, dignitaries, Eminent Engineer Awardees, delegates and participants. Dr Zope in his address focused on the role of engineering and technology for societal development.

Chairman, ARDB, IEI began his address by discussing the conceptualization of Architectural and Building engineering. He explained the role and scope of basic architecture and service engineering. Mr Deb elaborated on the salient points of National Building Code 2005 regarding the recognition of architectural engineering practice. He also emphasized the role of IEI in regulating the engineering profession in India.

Shri Rahul Ranjan Mahiwal, IAS, in his address, focused on the post pandemic transformation in construction practices. He highlighted interactive design and manufacture, enhanced collaboration among various stakeholders, and the increased application of digital tools, including Augmented Reality, Virtual Reality, Cyber Physical Systems etc., to solve real-world problems. Shri Mahiwal mentioned the application of Digital Twins, modular construction principles. He also emphasized the emerging area of health and wellness in architectural construction practices. Furthermore, he discussed resilient and sustainable building design and implementation, emphasizing the importance of greater exposure to the global emerging engineering practices.

The Guest of Honour, Dr Amarnath C B, delivered a lecture on the topic 'Digital Transformation Trend in India's Built Environment' and highlighted the digitalization of projects at different levels. He explained the benefits of implementing the Building Information into the Model (BIM) interface in terms of design, construction, asset management, operation and maintenance. Additionally, he discussed global initiatives related to BIM. Dr Amarnath further elaborated on the digital transformation strategy in the Indian context for construction projects and the strategic initiatives undertaken by the Government of India to monitor the progress of construction projects on digital platforms.

Dr Kavita Murugkar, Principal, Bharti Vidyapeeth College of Architecture, Katraj, Pune, delivered the Keynote lecture on the topic 'Emerging Disruptions in Construction Industry'. She highlighted the paradigm shift in construction practice from the project based approach to a product-based approach, focusing on mass customization. Dr Murugkar discussed the impact of rapid urbanization on the resources, habitats and environmental sustainability. The speaker explained the data-driven decision-making system in smart cities, emphasizing the integration of data and operations to achieve smart mobility, a smart economy and greater interconnectivity. She advocated for promoting green buildings, green energy and evidence-based decision-making process etc. Dr. Murugkar elaborated on the integrated approach of building design, specifically Building Information Management Modeling. Additionally, she discussed the role of Augmented Reality (AR) and Virtual Reality (VR) in Construction Management and highlighted the process of digital model building through Drone Photogrammetry. The speaker also explored the functional applications of the disruptive materials in the construction industry, such as light gauge steel, mass timber, nano crystals, pollution-absorbing bricks, etc. She further mentioned the importance of adaptive reuse of buildings and technological empowerment.

The Technical Proceedings, containing the papers presented during the

National Convention, were released on the dais in the presence of esteemed dignitaries. Er Nand Lal Chandel, Architect-in-Chief (F), PWD, Government of Himachal Pradesh; Er Sanjay Kumar Singh, Executive Head, Ashraya Consulting Engineers; and Er H N Somani, Professional Architectural Engineer, Interior Designer & Government Registered Valuer were felicitated as Eminent Engineering Personalities for their significant contributions to the field of Architectural Engineering. Er D G Patil, the programme convener, briefed the audience about the theme, and Prof A N Gedam, the co-convener and Organising Secretary, delivered the opening remarks. Er Vipin Munot, Honorary Secretary of the Pune Local Centre, proposed the vote of thanks.

The inaugural session was followed by T S Narayana Rao Memorial Lecture, delivered by Er Kiran S Kalamdani, Architect - Urban Designer - Conservation Architect, Partner, Kimaya Architects Urban Designers, Conservationist, Valuer, Interior Designer, and Consortium Member - Pilgrimage Development Group (PDG) on the topic 'Conservation of Architectural Heritage'. In his lecture, Er Kalamdani shared his experience about the conservation of the reputed heritage structures, advents of arts and historical research, challenges in restoration and conservation and so on.

During the first technical session, Dr S P Anchuri from Hyderabad delivered a Keynote address on 'Regenerative Architectural Engineering and Design of Buildings.' He emphasized the importance of green architecture and sustainable building ecosystems, and further discussed regenerative design and biophilic design. Dr Amarnath C B delivered a lecture on 'Standardizing BIM Implementation in Indian Infrastructure Projects,' explaining the benefits of Building Information Modeling (BIM) in the Architecture, Engineering,



Construction, and Operation (AECO) industry. The lecture covered BIM implementation in residential and commercial projects and outlined a strategic roadmap for developing BIM guidelines.

Other presentations included Er Purushottam P Doijode, Joint Director (Arch), Military Engineer Services, Gandhinagar, who spoke about 'Analyzing Smart City vis-a-vis Smart Building Case Studies Comprehending Sustainable Smart Developments.' Dr D M Kudale, Former Additional Director, CWQPRS, Pune, presented a paper on 'Coastal Developments,' focusing on constructions in disaster-prone areas, coastal zone management, and coastal ecology. Lt Col Rahul Kumar delivered a presentation on 'Concept of Thermal Bridge in Building Construction,' highlighting energy-efficient buildings and the application of thermal bridge concepts in heating and cooling. Er Sameer Bapat from M/s Outinord Formwork Systems provided customized solutions for standardized projects. Er Visakha R Natekar delivered a presentation on 'Construction Planning for the Next Generation of Rural Coastal India,' and Er Suresh Babu, Founder and Principal of Suresh Babu & Partners, discussed the 'Changing Roles of Architects and Architectural Engineers.'

During the second technical session, Prof Anita Benniger, Director of ESDS, Mumbai, delivered a Keynote lecture on 'Affordable Slum Rehabilitation.' She elaborated on case studies of slum rehabilitation in Dharavi slum, Mumbai, Shirole Vasti, Pune, and other locations. M/s Wienerberger delivered a presentation on 'Smart Bricks,' and Dr Arundhati Wategave, Principal of

is believed to reveal the hidden relationships between primary/secondary pollutants and source/meteorological parameters/variables. Researchers are interested in employing advanced modeling approaches that incorporate chemical/physical relevance, as well as data-driven/data mining/Al-based frameworks to explore these relationships and predict future outcomes. However, all modeling approaches come with a certain level of uncertainty, which affects the reliability of the model's visualization. The speaker further explained that handling uncertainty in model development depends on the sequential process followed by the modeler.

Dr J N Chary, Director of Health and Safety at Swan Environmental Private Limited, Hyderabad, delivered a presentation on 'Environmental and Industrial Hygiene Monitoring.' The speaker elaborated on emissions from urban environments and industrial or agricultural operations. Power generation was emphasized as a focal point for preventing hazardous pollutants from posing health risks to the population. The deliberation revealed that emission monitoring is crucial not only for protecting the environment but also for ensuring the safety and compliance of industrial emissions. The implementation of a Continuous Emission Monitoring System (CEMS) is

important for meeting environmental regulations, reducing exposure to on-site personnel and nearby communities. The speaker also highlighted the importance of gas emission and particulate monitoring for improving operations, reducing operating costs, complying with EPA emissions regulations, and meeting OSHA regulations for employee health and plant safety.

Dr A Gandhimathi, Associate Professor in the Department of Civil Engineering at Kumaraguru College of Technology, Coimbatore, delivered a lecture on 'Prediction of Air Pollution using Machine Learning Techniques.' The speaker conducted a survey that indicated high levels of PM 2.5 at the construction site in the Thudiyalur area and the Foundry Industrial Zone. High levels of NOx were observed in City Hall and Goundam Palayam due to traffic congestion. The aim of this analysis was to study the concentration of air pollutants in the ambient air at different locations near industries and throughout the city of Coimbatore.

Additionally, technical papers were presented on topics such as 'Low-Cost Sensor (LCS) Indoor Air Quality Module for Particulate Matter Monitoring: Variable Dependent Analysis' and 'Machine Learning Algorithms in Ambient Air Quality Prediction.'

Architecture College, Sangli, Maharashtra, delivered a Keynote lecture on 'Sustainable Urbanism.' The session also included paper presentations on topics such as 'Smart Home,' 'Zero Energy Building,' 'Time and Motion Study of Labor,' and 'Artificial Intelligence in the Construction Industry.'

In the third technical session, Prof (Dr) Smita Suryavanshi from the Department of Architecture, Singhad College of Architecture, delivered a keynote lecture on 'Digital, Parametric, and Futuristic Architecture.' She discussed digital and parametric architecture, architectural aesthetics and functionality, adaptive and contextual design, economically viable design, alternative design solutions, design through biomimicry, generative architecture, and more. Ms Dhanashree Sardeshpande, Associate Professor at Dr B N College of Architecture, Pune, delivered a keynote address on the topic 'Digital Paradigm in Architecture - Disruptions and the Way Ahead.' Her address covered the evolution of digital architecture, the application of computational geometry, form finding through optimization, integrated computation design, core concrete technology, precise project monitoring with Global Navigation Satellite System (GNSS), digital optimization, form finding loop, and other related aspects.

Other presentations included a paper by Er Mahesh Mokha, Managing Director of Mokha Financial and Industrial Consultants (P) Limited, on 'Geodesic Geometry - through a Case Study.' Er Purushottam P Doijode also delivered a presentation on 'Exploring the Role of Women Architects, Designers, and Engineers in Construction Realizing Sustainable Development across India.' Shri Ajay Kumar, Director of Aayka Waterproofers Private Limited, presented on waterproofing products.

Inadequate infrastructural facilities in urban areas with increased population and designing an appropriate remedial roadmap be properly addressed. Addressing and monitoring increased air, water, and noise pollution in urban areas be provided on urgent basis. Designing suitable remedial measures and preparing guidelines to reduce pollution be prioritized.

Science journals explicitly state that AI, including ChatGPT, cannot be listed as authors, and the use of AI-generated text without proper citation is considered plagiarism.

While global publishers may not accept ChatGPT and similar tools as authors in research, researchers can still leverage Al tools to enhance their work in other meaningful ways. However, this prompts us to reevaluate the concept of authorship in research and drive improvements within the academic community.

This evolving landscape of Al writing tools calls for researchers to consider the future implications. Thoughtful discussions and exploration of responsible research practices are necessary to better understand and utilize Al writing tools. By embracing technological advancements with caution and wisdom, we can ensure a future that harnesses the power of Al while upholding the integrity and accountability vital to the research community.

As we navigate this changing landscape, it is crucial for the research community to seize this opportunity. Engaging in meaningful conversations and seeking avenues for improvement will enable us to make informed decisions regarding the utilization of Al writing tools. By doing so, we can pave the way for a future that embraces the benefits of Al while preserving the integrity of research.

PROCEDURE FOR CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS

(As approved by the Council at its 689th meeting held at Ahmedabad, on 02-03 April, 2016 and amended at its 690th Meeting held at Durgapur on 26 Jun 2016, at its 691st Meeting held on 24-25 Sep 2016 at Haridwar, at its 706th meeting held on 21 Sep 2019 at Mumbai, at its 707th meeting held on 29 Dec 2019 at Hyderabad and as circulated subsequently)

- 1. Unless specified otherwise, following clauses in the 'Procedure for Conduct of Elections' will be applicable for all elections under provision of Regulations 24, 25 and 26.
- 2. The Corporate members on the roll of the Institution as on 31 Mar of the year in which elections are due shall form the electorate college for the elections which will be prepared and supplied by the IEI HQs.
- 3. The BOS will access the Control Panel of the Election software by using their login credentials which would be strictly confidential.

Inviting self-nominations

- 4. The Board of Scrutineers shall invite self-nominations alongwith biodata and non-refundable earnest money of the requisite amount from the eligible Corporate Members in the following ways:
 - (a) Through notification in the publication (if any) circulated to all the Corporate Members eligible to contest in the election.
 - (b) By sending email to the Corporate Members eligible to contest in the election and having valid email ids as registered with IEI as on 31 Mar of the year.
 - (c) By displaying in the notice board and website of the IEI for election under Regulation 24.
 - (d) By displaying in the notice board and website (if any) of the respective Centre for election under Regulation 25 and 26.

Such bio-data shall be uploaded as received from the concerned nominated members and the Board of Scrutineers shall not be responsible for correctness or otherwise of such information. The invitation for nomination should also include the election time table mentioning important dates in the election process as fixed by the BOS in consultation with the IEI HQs.

The amount of earnest money as decided by the Council at its 691st and 715th meetings is as follows:

- i. For election to the Council seat Rs.20,000
- ii. For election to the State Centre Committee Rs.5,000
- iii. For election to the Local Centre Committee Rs.3,000

The earnest money should be paid by Demand Draft in favour of "The Institution of Engineers (India)", payable at Kolkata or by direct electronic remittance to the HQs.

In case of electronic remittance, the receipt of payment should be attached with the nomination papers and forwarded immediately to the IEI HQs.

Submitting self-nominations along with other requisites

5. A Corporate Member willing to contest in the election shall nominate himself and submit the nomination alongwith biodata and the earnest money. The nomination shall include the name, the class of membership, Division and the Membership number of the Corporate Member. The bio-data shall be circulated as received from the concerned nominated members but may be abridged to limit it to one hundred words and the Board of Scrutineers shall not be responsible for correctness or otherwise of such information.

A period of minimum 15 days from the last date of sending emails inviting nominations shall be allowed for submitting the nominations along with other requisites for elections under Regulations 25 and 26. For election under Regulation 24, minimum 30 days from the last date of sending emails inviting nominations shall be allowed for submitting the nominations along with other requisites. The earnest money paid during submission of nomination shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

The notification shall direct that a member attached to a Division shall be eligible to submit nomination for election (under Regulation 24 and 25) only in that Division. The candidate shall also submit, an acceptable proof of his identity, viz PAN card or Driving License or Photo ID Card issued by State/Central Government bearing his signature or Photo ID Card of The Institution bearing his signature or first page of his passport duly self attested.

Scrutiny of Nominations

6. On expiry of the last date of receipt of nomination, the Board of Scrutineers shall meet and scrutinize the nomination papers and verify the validity of the nominations, rejecting the nominations which may be found to be invalid on account of their not being in conformity with the above requirements or under Regulation 23(c).

BOS Control Panel

7. The BOS can access the BOS Control Panel of Election software only after they log-in with their membership number as log-in ID and requisite password. This password shall be made available to them by the Administrator. Before the first log-in, they will be required to change their password. BOS members have to create their own password and have to keep it strictly confidential.

- 8. (a) Computer auto generated log-in credentials for online voting shall be sent through the mobile / e-mail to the electronically reachable members as on 31 Mar of the year on the day prior to the opening day of the election.
- (b) An eligible voter visiting the Institution website www.ieindia.org will be guided to the election portal. The voter can access the voting page of the relevant election by using log-in ID and password for voting online. A system generated One Time Password shall be sent to the registered Mobile / e-mail for casting of vote electronically. The One time Password shall have a validity of five minutes. Separate One time Password shall be issued for all elections. The vote cast by a voter shall be encrypted and not available to anyone. The details of the voter by his membership number shall be available in the system. The electronic voting details cannot be downloaded and vote cast is encrypted. The bio data of the contestants will be available for voters reference in the election portal. The e-voting period shall be 14 days for all elections under Regulations 24, 25 and 26.
- (c) In case a voter misplaces his password or has not received it for any reasons, he can request for computer auto-generated log-in ID and password from the HOME page of the IEI election web site which can be accessed through www.ieindia.org, which shall be sent to his mobile / e-mail.
- (d) In case of members residing abroad who have registered their e-mail id, they will be provided the log-in credentials through his e-mail only.

Security

- 9. A voter can log in using his / her password issued to him in his / her registered mobile / e-mail on the starting day of the election. However, while casting the vote, a system generated One Time Password (OTP) shall be sent to his / her registered mobile / e-mail. Voter has to use that password for casting his / her vote. The validity of the OTP shall be for five minutes only or till its first successful use whichever is earlier.
- 10. The election Web service provider is to provide the source code under sealed cover to the Secretary and Director General for the purpose of record and safe custody. The Source Code is not to be opened and is to be kept sealed.
- 11. In case any correction/ change required by the BOS due to wrong entry/ change of schedule etc. a communication is to be sent by the Convenor, BOS to the Administrator i.e. the Secretary and Director General. On receipt of such request, the Administrator shall arrange for necessary corrections, if feasible.
- 12. The software is to also have feature of automatic logging out if no activity takes place for 10 minutes. After automatic logging out, re-logging by all three to access the site is to be made mandatory.
- 13. The electronic voting shall end at 2400 hours on the date specified and no voting on web can be done thereafter.

Final counting

14. On the date of counting the system shall count the online votes and final

result shall be available to BOS instantly. In the event of a tie, the BOS shall decide the result by toss of coin or by drawing lots, as per the existing provision.

Bio data

- 15. The Bio data of the contestant if furnished, as finalized by the BOS, shall be uploaded on the election site. This shall be available in public domain. It shall also be available for view to the voter while casting the vote on web.
- 16. The Bio data of the contestants shall also be published in the Centre's Newsletter.

Result

- 17. The BOS shall print the report on the result of the voting which shall be signed by the members of the BOS present and present the report along with connected papers to the Chairman of the Centre and forward a copy of the report to the Honorary Secretary of the Centre and also to the Secretary & Director General of the Institution for necessary action.
- 18. The Honorary Secretary shall immediately communicate official results of the election to the Secretary & Director General. The voting papers shall be sealed and kept by the Chairman of the Centre till 30 days after the ensuing AGM of the Centre whereafter they shall be destroyed, as per the existing proviso.

For election to Council under Bye-law 4(a)(iii) the voting papers need to be

preserved till 30 days of the Institution's AGM, whereafter they shall be destroyed. Similarly details of all the web voting shall be dealt with by the Administrator.

- 19. The BOS shall conduct all business of election from the premises of the Centre. In no case activities of election can be carried out from premises other than the Centre.
- 20. The Chairman and the Honorary Secretary in the office and the Chairmanelect and Honorary Secretary-elect shall not be members of the BOS.
- 21. No person shall be member of BOS for more than two consecutive elections.
- 22. The Chairman / Honorary Secretary of the Centre, without involving himself in operational activities of the BOS, shall oversee the functioning of the BOS to ensure that the procedure is not violated inadvertently.

In case the Chairman / Honorary Secretary himself is a candidate in any of the elections being conducted at the Centres of which he is the Chairman / Honorary Secretary and candidate(s) in the election to the Council from the Division Board, he should not be involved in any of the activities relating to the election process at the Centre. In such case, the State/Local Centre Committee may resolve to authorize an appropriate available non-candidate corporate member preferably past Chairman to oversee the functioning of the BOS without involving himself in operational activities of the BOS.

News-in-Brief

The following are the brief account of Technical Activities organised by various Centres

STATE CENTRES

Andaman & Nicobar

Organized a seminar on 'Waterproofing, Flooring, and Repair Products' on 25 August 2022. The speaker of the event, Er Abrar Suleman, Head of Project Marketing at Asian Paints, discussed the range of products available for waterproofing and sealing operations. A video demonstration showcased the practical application of these products in real-life projects. Mr N Naresh, Senior Manager (Marketing) at Asian Paints, explained the application procedure for various waterproofing compounds. Er Rakesh, Area Manager (Technical) at Asian Paints, provided insights into the chemical composition of different sealants and their applications.

Gujarat

On the occasion of the 63rd Foundation Day of Gujarat State Centre, IEI, a Technical Talk on 'Revamping Engineering Education in India' was organized on 1 September 2022 in association with the Water Management Forum of IEI.
