

IEI has been conducting its well recognized engineering education programme popularly known as AMIE since pioneering the same in 1928.

IEI, headquartered in Kolkata, India and administered by a Council led by its President, operates through 125 State and Local Centres located in the State capitals and towns of industrial and academic importance all over the country along with seven fora and an organ namely Engineering Staff College of India (ESCI), Hyderabad. The Secretary and Director General is the Chief Executive Officer of the Institution.

IEI Students' Chapters



Fees for Opening/Renewal of Students' Chapter at **Engineering Colleges/Polytechnics**

In a College/University/Institution, at least fifty numbers (50) of students irrespective of the year of study in the same branch of engineering is required for opening a Students' Chapter.

To enable formation of Chapter in any recognized polytechnic minimum number of student required is fifty (50). There shall be only one Chapter in Polytechnic.
