India is one of the rapidly advancing countries in the world in terms of science, innovation and technology. India has now obtained the sixth position in the world in scientific publications ahead of countries like France, Spain and Italy. India is third globally in nanotech research and fourth in weather forecasting and is among the five topmost nations in the world in the field of scientific research and space exploration. India is working towards establishing itself as a leader in industrialization and technological development and is indulging itself into various cutting edge technologies in the nuclear energy sector, nanotechnology, pharmaceutical industry, agriculture sector etc. Government of India, through its numerous policies aspires to position India among the world's top five scientific powers. The policies aim to bring in the concept of robust policy governance mechanism incorporating features such as periodic review, policy evaluation, feedback, and adaptation, and a timely exit strategy for various policy instruments.

The Indian pharmaceutical industry is showing a tremendous growth resulting from Covid-19 products. There are programmes to identify several start-ups in various sectors such as telemedicine, digital health and mHealth with big data, artificial intelligence, blockchain and other technologies. Development of first Rotavirus Vaccine, Clot Buster Protein (Clot Specific Streptokinase) and launching of new programme to rejuvenate deeper scientific research in yoga and meditation are signs of the upcoming expansions. A large number of drugs, diagnostic kits and healthcare products have been developed and transferred to industry for commercialization in the last four years. Further, the country has regularly undertaken space missions, including missions to the moon and the famed Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle. Recently, the Government launched the Indian Space Association to accelerate technology advancements and strengthen the space sector in the country. DRDO developed an anti-drone technology to detect and neutralize unmanned aerial vehicles. This technology uses radar system that offers 360 degree coverage. National Aerospace Limited under CSIR has designed and developed India's first civilian aircraft which will be cheaper than any imported aircraft in the same category with far more benefits. Next, Indian agriculture is primarily dependent on monsoon rains and lately changes in weather due to climate change have resulted in unpredictability of rain systems. Timely information on weather to farmers benefits them hugely to plan farming operations and as a result its impact on economic is immense. Geo-imaging satellites enable near-real time monitoring of natural disasters such as floods and cyclones. With the acquisition of fourth fastest supercomputer in the world, weather and climate research in India has also improved tremendously. ICAR signed a MoU with the Digital India Corporation to provide location-specific demand-based tele-agriculture advisories. Gamma irradiation technology for food preservation processing plants is now operational in the country in private, semi government and government sector for irradiation of various products. Projects like Deep Ocean Mission which is a multi-ministerial, multi-disciplinary programme to develop deep-sea technologies such as manned submersibles and enable deep-sea mining, exploration of deep-sea mineral resources and marine biodiversity, acquisition of a research vessel to explore oceans, conduct deep-sea observations and build capacities in marine biology research has also approved by the Central Government. In addition to this, India offers various opportunities for research & development and innovations. Till date most innovative firms across the world have a research and development centre in India. Our country is establishing collaborations with various technically rich countries world-wide for development of research and developments and their expansions.

As a Chairman, All India Students Committee, I would request you to explore the various emerging fields in engineering and technology as it can create new avenues for the young engineers.

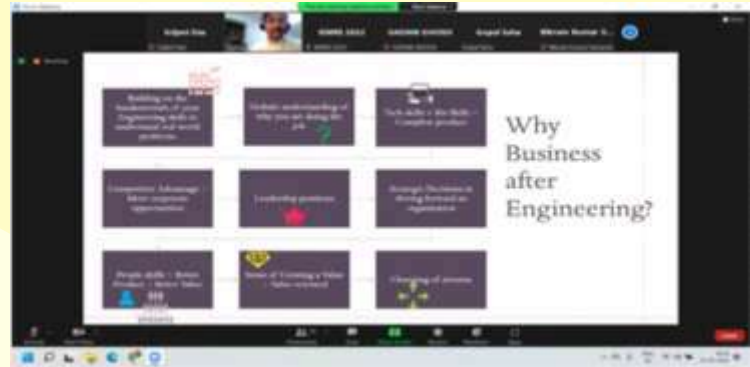

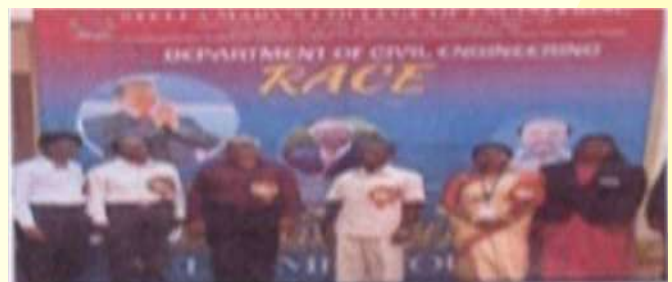

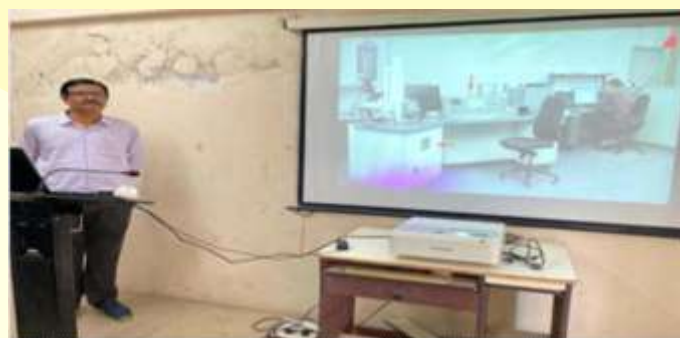

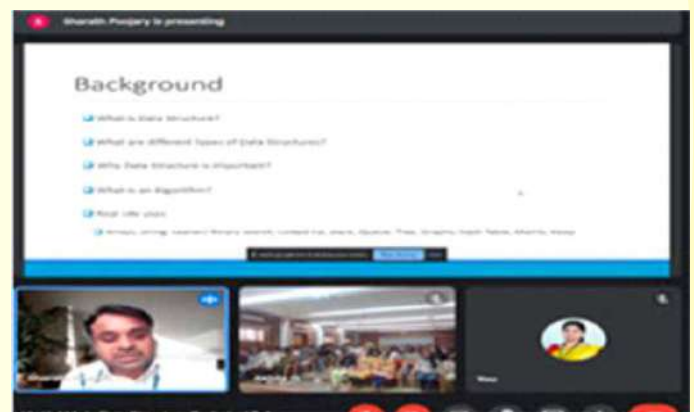

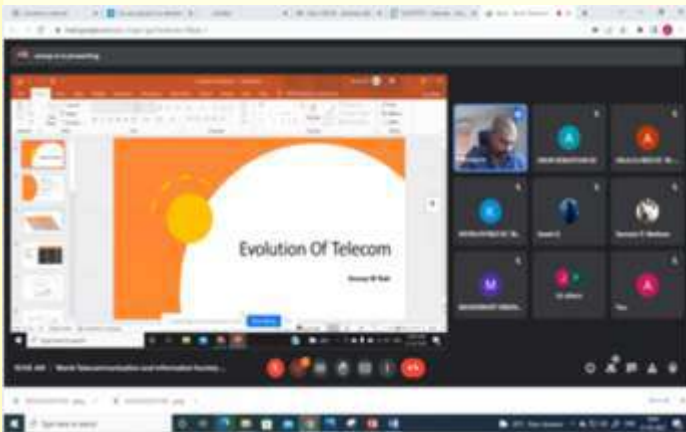

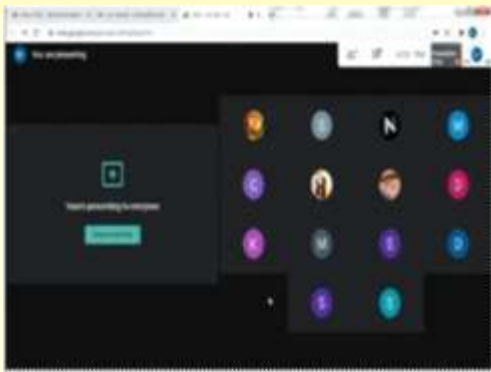

# Steps to establish IET Students' Chapters in Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics may establish Students' Chapter of IET with atleast fifty students pursuing engineering in the same branch of a College/University/Institution and be a part of the IET fraternity following steps below:

- Initial request from an engineering college/a polytechnic is to be made to the Director (Membership) of IET expressing desire to open a Students' Chapter at the Engineering College/Polytechnic mentioning the branches of engineering.
- (i) In a College/University/Institution, at least **fifty numbers (50)** of students irrespective of the year of study in the same branch of engineering is required for opening a Students' Chapter.
- (ii) To enable formation of a Chapter in any recognized polytechnic minimum number of member required is **fifty (50)**. There shall be only one Chapter in a polytechnic.

This strength of membership shall be mandatory for opening as also for continuing a Students Chapter. However, it's requested to motivate all the students to enroll themselves in the chapter.

- Upon obtaining the permission and code of the new Students' Chapter from IET, prospective Chapters have to download the forms [for engineering college Students' Members (ECSC) and Polytechnic Students' Member (PSC)] from the webpage [www.iindia.org](http://www.iindia.org). The forms have to be filled up by the students willing for members of Students' Chapter in consultation with the Adviser.
- The requisite fee to be collected from each student as per the year of study as given below.
