

Steps to establish IET Students' Chapters in Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics

- Upon obtaining the permission and code of the new Students' Chapter from IET, prospective Chapters have to download the forms [for engineering college Students' Members (ECSC) and Polytechnic Students' Member (PSC)] from the webpage www.ietindia.org . The forms have to be filled up by the students willing for members of Students' Chapter in consultation with the Adviser.
