Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 6 aims to ensure the availability and sustainable management of water and sanitation for everyone, everywhere. Clean water and sanitation are fundamental human rights and essential for the well-being of people and the health of the planet. However, billions of people worldwide still lack access to safe water and basic sanitation, and the pressure on water resources is growing due to population increases, urbanization, climate change, and pollution.

The key focus of SDG is ensuring that all people, regardless of location, have access to clean drinking water, sanitation, and hygiene facilities. It also emphasizes on prevention of pollution from industrial, agricultural, and domestic sources and protecting the quality of freshwater resources and promotion of sustainable use of water resources, reducing waste, and improving water management in agriculture, industry, and communities. The water resources should be managed in a way that balances the needs of people, agriculture, industry, and ecosystems. Freshwater ecosystems, such as rivers, lakes, and wetlands are to be protected and restored to maintain the natural water cycle.

Engineers play a critical role in achieving SDG 6 by designing, developing, and implementing the technologies and infrastructure needed for sustainable water and sanitation management. Their expertise in systems design, construction, environmental science, and data analysis is essential for tackling the complex challenges of water scarcity, water pollution, and inefficient water use. Engineers also design and operate water treatment plants that purify water to make it safe for drinking and industrial use. They develop systems for sewage treatment that prevent pollution and protect public health. Civil and environmental engineers design and maintain water supply systems, including pipelines, pumping stations, and storage reservoirs, to ensure that water is distributed efficiently and reliably to communities. They develop solutions to reduce water waste, such as rainwater harvesting, drip irrigation, and greywater recycling. Environmental engineers design systems to control and treat pollution from industrial, agricultural, and residential sources. Engineers are increasingly focusing on sustainable infrastructure, using materials and technologies that reduce environmental impact including designing green buildings, sustainable water storage solutions, and systems that promote the reuse of water. They assess the impacts of climate change on water resources and help design infrastructure that can withstand extreme weather events such as floods and droughts. Last but not the least, engineers play a key role in the development of data collection and monitoring systems that track water quality, usage, and availability. They use sensor networks, remote sensing technologies, and data analytics to optimize water management.

Achieving SDG 6 requires the collective effort of governments, communities, and professionals across many fields, but engineers are especially vital to its success. Their role in designing, building, and maintaining the infrastructure and technologies that deliver clean water and sanitation is crucial to overcoming the challenges of water access and management. By combining innovation, sustainability, and technical expertise, engineers can help ensure that water resources are available for future generations while improving health and livelihoods today.

Therefore, on behalf of AISC I would like to kindly request that all Students' Chapters organize technical activities focusing on the crucial areas of water availability and sustainable sanitation management. These activities aim to raise awareness among upcoming engineers about the challenges faced in sustaining water resources and ensuring effective sanitation solutions.

Steps to establish IEI Students' Chapters in

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics

Engineering Colleges/ Polytechnics may establish Students' Chapter of IEI with at least fifty students pursuing engineering in the same branch of a College/University/Institution and be a part of the IEI fraternity following steps below:

- Initial request from an engineering college/a polytechnic is to be made to the Deputy Director (Membership) of IEI expressing desire to open a Students' Chapter at the Engineering College/Polytechnic mentioning the branches of engineering.
- (i) In a College/University/Institution, at least **thirty numbers (30)** of students irrespective of the year of study in the same branch of engineering is required for opening a Students' Chapter other than Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering Department and Computer Science Engineering Department.
- (ii) In a College/University/Institution, at least **fifty numbers (50)** of students is required for Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering Department and Computer Science Engineering Department irrespective of the year of study.
- (iii) To enable formation of a Chapter in any recognized polytechnic minimum number of member required is **fifty (50)**. There shall be only one Chapter in a polytechnic.

This strength of membership shall be mandatory for opening as also for continuing a Students Chapter. However, it's requested to motivate all the students to enroll themselves with the Chapter.

- Upon obtaining the permission and code of the new Students' Chapter from IEI, prospective Chapters have to download the forms [for engineering college Students' Members (ECSC) and Polytechnic Students' Member (PSC)] from www.ieindia.org. The forms have to be filled up by the willing students for becoming members of Students' Chapter in consultation with the Adviser.
- The requisite fee to be collected from each student as per the year of study are given below.
